Subject: Revised List of Statutory Crimes

Program Issue: This transmittal reissues the list of statutory crimes that prohibit an individual from being eligible to receive reimbursement as a child care provider from Care 4 Kids. The list has been revised to include the addition of **Strangulation in the 1st and 2nd Degree** and to make the crime of **Prostitution- Patronage and Promoting** disqualify an individual if the crime occurred in the last 5 years.

Background: CGS 17b-749k requires the department to conduct criminal background checks on unlicensed non-relative providers providing child care in a child's home. The statute also allows a criminal background check to be conducted on any unlicensed provider if there is reason to believe that the individual has been convicted of certain crimes.

Implementation: Effective with this transmittal, the attached list of statutory crimes replaces the list issued on January 30, 2009. Individuals with a history of conviction for the crimes on the attached list are ineligible for Care 4 Kids reimbursement. Providers currently under arrest for any of the attached crimes are ineligible as well.
