



What is Early Start CT?

Early Start CT is the new state funding stream that combines the current School Readiness grants, Child Day Care Contracts, and State Head Start supplemental grants; it goes into effect July 1, 2025





Early Start CT Goals



Empower families and amplify parent voice to better meet the needs of Connecticut children.



Strengthen system collaboration and a shared vision to build lasting partnerships between community stakeholders.



Improve equitable access to affordable, high-quality care and early childhood services and supports that meet a range of family needs.

- **Promote best practices** to enhance provider's ability to support
- — children's learning and development.




Early Start Contract Overview

- To expedite contract execution, the OEC has worked with the Office of Attorney General on an approved ESCT contract template.
- Individual contracts **do not need** to go to the OAG for final approval.
- OAG approved templates **do not allow** for individual contract language change requests.
- The Early Start CT contract template follows the same structure as previously executed Child Day Care contracts BUT is more condensed and does not contain the content that is covered in General Policies.
- This week, OEC will begin **processing and sending contracts** to Vendors who have submitted the necessary forms and for which OEC has verified the business name in all systems.

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Timeline: ESCT training and launch

General Policies



General Policy: Attendance

General policy language

- Programs are required to utilize all statefunded spaces on a consistent basis.
- Children enrolled in Early Start CT spaces must attend the program <u>at least one (1) day</u> per monthly reporting period.

Relevant Guidance

What is a monthly reporting period?

Each calendar month of the year is a **monthly** reporting period

- For example: August 2025's monthly reporting period goes from August 1, 2025 – August 31, 2025
- The requirement of utilization of spaces one (1) day per monthly reporting period is a minimum. Programs are expected to have families consistently attend statefunded spaces.

General Policy: Reimbursement & Utilization Early Start CT

General policy language

Early Start CT

- Contractors are paid quarterly and in advance of services provided.
- Programs that utilize at least eightyfive percent (85%) of their assigned Early Start CT spaces each quarter will be paid a full quarterly payment.
- Programs that *do not* meet the eightyfive percent (85%) monthly utilization threshold will be paid based on utilized spaces only.

Relevant Guidance

How is utilization calculated?

- Utilized spaces will be calculated at the monthly report site level using ECE Reporter site data.
- ECE Reporter will automatically calculate utilization percentages and compute funds earned.
- Utilization is reconciled during the year to ensure accurate payments were made.



General Policy: Reimbursement & Utilization Early Start CT State Head Start

General policy language

Early Start CT State Head Start

- ESCT programs with State Head Start spaces will receive their full quarterly payment provided their utilization of spaces for the previous quarter is at least fifty percent (50%).
- If utilization falls below fifty percent (50%), programs will be required to meet with their assigned OEC Program Manager and submit a Utilization Plan explaining how the program will increase utilization, with timeline.
- If utilization does not increase by the end of the following quarter, funding may be reduced.

Relevant Guidance

How is utilization calculated?

- Utilized spaces will be calculated at the monthly report site level using ECE Reporter site data.
- ECE Reporter will automatically calculate utilization percentages.

*Children enrolled in a state-funded preschool space may not be eligible for kindergarten.



School Age Reimbursement Rates

Ages Served	Space Type Care Level	Definition	Annual Reimbursement Rate
Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12 years	School Age	Care that is provided at least 35 hours per week when school is not in session and 10-25 hours per week when school is in session.	\$4,125
Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12 years	School Age	Care that is provided at least 10-25 hours per week when school is in session, 10 months per year only.	\$2,700
Enrolled in Kindergarten - 12 years	School Age	Care that is provided at least 35 hours per week when school is NOT in session, 2 months per year only.	\$1,150


General Policy: Full Time Shared Space

General policy language

Programs may utilize a full-time space to serve one or two children. If a full-time space is split between two children, a minimum of 35 hours of care must be utilized between the two children weekly.

Relevant Guidance

ECE Reporter will have an option to choose if a child is attending a shared space. Programs will enter the hours the children each attended to meet the 35-hour a week minimum for a full time space reimbursement.
