Tools

Visuals (photographs, pictures, charts, etc.) at school and home help to communicate expectations to young children. Unlike verbal instructions, a visual provides the child with a symbol that helps the child to see and understand words, ideas, and expectations.

Visual schedules greatly limit the amount of "no's" and behavior corrections you need to give throughout the day, since children can better predict what should happen next.

News

Children may not respond to adult requests because they don't actually understand what is expected of them, and this can lead to tantrums, crying, or other challenging behavior.

A child is more likely to be successful when he or she is told specifically what to do rather than what not to do.
