Priority Testing for Child Care and Youth Camp Providers

Community Health Center (CHC) is providing expedited COVID-19 testing for our First Responders (e.g., early childhood providers, firefighters, police officers, teachers, National Guard, Public Works, school staff (including bus drivers), paramedics, EMTs, and dispatchers)

Staff presenting for priority testing will be asked to use the walk-up lane and identify themselves upon arrival. In case of inclement weather, use drive-in and identify yourself as first responder (teacher/school staff/early childhood provider) upon arrival to be moved ahead.

Staff must present their school ID or anything that shows they are associated with an early childhood program, such as a pay stub, a copy of the program's license, a business card, etc.

Priority testing is offered until 4 p.m. at all CHC COVID-19 Testing locations. Visit <https://www.chc1.com/covid-19-testing/> for information on testing sites.

Extended hours until 5 p.m. for priority testing is being piloted at the following sites:
