

Public Acts Recently Enacted

The following is a list of public acts that passed during a recent legislative session that are specific to the Office of Early Childhood's child day care and/or youth camp licensing programs. The text of each public act should be reviewed and may be accessed by visiting the Connecticut General Assembly's web site at cga.ct.gov and conducting a quick search by Public Act, entering the two or three digit number that appears after the "13" or "14" as the Number, and entering the corresponding year.

Public Act 13-208 An Act Concerning Various Revisions to the Public Health Statutes-Section 6-(child care)
Effective October 1, 2013

Public Act 14-15 An Act Concerning the Use of Public School Health Assessment Forms by Youth Camps and Day Care Centers-Sections 1 and 2-(child care and youth camps) Effective July 1, 2014

Public Act 14-36 An Act Concerning Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Certification-Section 1-(youth camps)
Effective October 1, 2014

Public Act 14-38 An Act Concerning the Recommendations of the Uniform Regional School Calendar Task Force, Licensure Exemptions for Certain After School Programs and Expanding Opportunities Under the Subsidized Training and Employment Program-Section 2-(child care) Effective July 1, 2014

Public Act 14-39 An Act Establishing the Office of Early Childhood, Expanding Opportunities for Early Childhood Education and Concerning Dyslexia and Special Education-Sections 48-59-(child care) and Sections 75-83-(youth camps) Effective July 1, 2014

Public Act 14-186 An Act Concerning the Department of Children and Families and the Protection of Children-Section 6-(youth camps) Effective October 1, 2014
